Dear Col. Gray-

As you can see by the date I have had a long wait. This is the 8th day and I am assured the last at this point. I understand now what delayed Miss Press. It seems inconceivable that Washn doesn't have a better idea of what goes on along the way. For reasons of security I am unable to report on a number of matters which will be of interest to you in this connection but will do so when I am able to communicate with you via the pouch. I do want to tell you here however that if we expect to get any people to our theater that we must obtain No. 2 priorities for them and even then we must get them on their way in the near future. I had my own priority raised to a 2 today. If it can be done here enroute certainly it can be done there where there is the authority and the channels provided we have someone ~~who~~ handles these matters who will make it his business to find out how the army operates in such matters and will follow thru for our people who are on their way over. I wish you would communicate this information to Major McD in the interests of the other theaters and tell him particularly that he must fight for 2's for those who are to join Rubinstein. ---- Now that I have a 2 I expect to see Turner S in about four days hence. Will cable you upon arrival. --- Everything I told you previously about equipment for our people still goes at this point. ---I have an old friend and former roommate here, Capt. Joseph E. Jones. If any of our tribe need assistance have them contact him. He always knows his way around. ---Please cable me Mrs. B's address once she gets established.
