- 3/14/45 - Cable: In 7377 cont. departure would jeopardize our entire activity. Caserta reports that subject's promotion was recommended last Oct. and has now been referred for slot clearance therefore request for action before subject leaves. Remainder of cable is relay of cable to Murphy from Bishop in Istanbul; Cable: In 6301, #48327.
- 3/14/45 - Pouch: XX010-1403 (XX010-314) from London to Wash. Fortnightly Report. Subject ordered to withdraw from the Balkans which makes the personnel situation in that area acute.
- 3/15/45 - Pouch: GX010-315, from Istanbul to Wash. Subject spent a few days in Istanbul discussing problems of mutual interest with Joseph Curtiss. Closer liaison between the two stations is desirable now that traffic between Turkey and the Balkans is gradually being reopened.
- 3/15/45 - Pouch: JCX010-315 from Hqrs. 2677th Regt. to Wash. Subject has been slated for reassignment in another theater and it is planned that the Chief X-2 Bari will temporarily supervise the Bucharest field until a successor arrives. In addition to his X-2 duties subject has also been engaged in extensive extra-curricular activities for the Commanding General AC, Roumania. This has involve his traveling between Bucharest and Istanbul for AC.
- 3/19/45 - Cable: Out 6635, #9934 from Wash. (Donovan) to Paris (Murphy). Situation re subject is not entirely clear as to whether he has followed the instructions to report to London. If subject still remains send cable from "Donovan"

- 3/19/45 - Cable: Out 6635 con't. requesting subject to follow Murphy's orders.
- 4/23/45 - Cable: In 11035 from Caserta. Request for ETO TCA and APR for subject's return to Wash. Subject arrived in Caserta 4/23/45.
- 4/30/45 - Pouch: JCX010-430 from 2677th Regt. to Wash. Subject is at present in Caserta preparing a report on X-2 activities at Bucharest.
- 5/24/45 - Cable: Out 12388, #35234 to Caserta & Out 12389, #24654 to London from Wash. Wash. requests to be advised on status of subject's case, and believes that subject should be sent immediately to Wash. where the case will be settled. Subject should be sent without military status being changed.
- 6/5/45 - Cable: In 15092, #51301 from Caserta to Wash. Donovan ordered reclassification on subject; matter is out of X-2 hands thus. Wash. will be advised re subject's departure date.
- 8/9/45 - Cable: Out 19746, #2104 to Rome from Wash. Re top-secret pouch on subject. Subject should see copy and request that his comments been sent to Wash. Request for status on subject.
- 8/14/45 - Cable: In 21563, #2464 from Rome to Wash. Top-Secret pouch in Hosler's hands. Subject waiting the results of Judge Advocate's investigation.

- 9/17/45 - Cable: In 24369, # 2187 from Rome to Wash. Subject ordered to Naples Hospital for psychiatric tests. Further action re court martial to be suspended until Donovan's arrival.
- 9/20/45 - Cable: In 24615, #2887 from Rome to Wash. Full report on subject's case to be pouched 9/19/45. Subject was refused admittance to hospital. Charges will now be filed.
- 10/11/45 - Cable: In 26155, #4967 to Wash. Action Director from Rome. Inspector General MTOUSA that action against subject be taken on 104th AW. This would probably involve our issuing reprimand, but if so would debar and further disciplinary action you may wish to take in States. I recommend action under 104. What are your instructions.
- 10/12/45 - Cable: Out 1868, #18687 to Rome from Director. If theater says subject is to be tried under 104 Article of War, we should accept theater decision.
