1. RE PARA 2A REF: TO BEST OUR KNOWLEDGE NO KUBARK STAFFER OR OTHER AMERICAN MET BLEY. NEWHAM/[] DID DISCUSS VARIOUS PENDING LEGAL ACTIONS WITH BLEY. DURING 25-27 NOV ALL AGREED NOT TO PRESS ANY CASE. [] STATEMENTS NOT DISCUSSED BUT BLEY RAISED POSSIBILITY OF CLAIMING ODYOKE INTERESTS AFFECTED BY VARIOUS STRAFANZEIGEN AGAINST DTLINEN. (MUST ASSUME BLEY USED SAME REASONING AS CANTOR). NEWHAM VETOED SUCH ACTION.

2. RE PARA 2B REF: SUHR/BLEY MEETING WAS SOCIAL AFFAIR AS BOTH OLD FRIENDS. DTLINEN PROBLEM RAISED BY MRS SUHR AND SUHR TOOK IT FROM THERE. BLEY BELIEVES HE CONVINCED SUHR COMMISSION WAS WORTHWHILE EFFORT. ALSO POSSIBILITY OF LAW ON COLD WAR ACTIVITIES INCLUDING DTLINEN'S WAS DISCUSSED. LATTER NOTHING NEW RAISED IN 15 NOV SUHR PRESS CONFERENCE. BOB IMPRESSION THAT SUCH LAW BEING DISCUSSED IN BONN UNOFFICIAL CIRCLES.

B. CAJERSEY OFFERED CHANCE PARTICIPATE JOINT HANOVER OFFICE WITH [] NEWHAM VETOED THIS.

C. [] OFFERED NEWHAM ADK FACILITIES DISTRIBUTE DTLINEN MATERIAL ON INCREASED BASIS.

5. RE EMBARGO ON GOVT OFFICE VISITS, THIS ALREADY IN EFFECT. CANNOT STOP DTLINEN FRIENDS INCLUDING ECKERT, BLEY, MOZER, COPPEE ET AL FROM MAKING REPRESENTATIONS. NEWHAM STILL MEMBER EUROPEAN UNION MOVEMENT AND VISITED BY NUMBER OF DELEGATES DURING RECENT BERLIN CONGRESS ALL OF WHOM OFFERED THEIR SUPPORT.
