SUBJECT: Travel to ROME and ATHENS

TO : 013

1. Investigation with Captain RUPP, Travel Clearance Section, Adjutant General Division, reveals the following:

a. For travel to Italy an American officer needs an Italian visa on his orders and an AGO card. Civilian clothes need not be worn.

b. Travelling to Greece, if MATS aircraft is used, a visa is not needed on the orders. If other means of transportation is used, a visa on the orders is necessary. An AGO card is the only other identification necessary. Civilian clothes need not be worn.

2. Inclosed are two immunization cards which can be made out for Mr. MAIR.

3. Dog tags and ration cards can be issued by this headquarters before subject goes on travel.
