1. The details of the report contained in the Pullach cable have been forwarded, and add little to the cabled account. "Gisgang Emmanuel von ROHMENBORG is further described as having been arrested for "a phony uranium deal" and the attempted swindle of a Geneva merchant, named KAISER. In the course of the inquiry it developed that he was "active in intelligence work for the USA; that he worked as a courier for a legitimist organization; and that, although a German refugee from the East Zone, he procured Austrian documentation from Walter AUSSERLEBNER. Also suspected in this documentation fraud was Dr. Leopold VOLLER, of Salzburg, who was arrested in Feldkirch."

2. We have no traces on any of these persons, except those which were forwarded in our cable, and the following on VOLLER. According to MGL-A-1735 and MGL-A-1736, Dr. Leopold VOLLER is a contact of Dr. Wolfram BITSCHEAU, a USAGE contact, also in touch with the French service. USAGE reported in January 1950 that VOLLER was working for Mr. CHESEK of OIC, Salzburg in January 1948. He allegedly was arrested on a narcotics charge, but was released by Mr. Dr NOVY of OIC, Salzburg, when he stated he was working for U.S. intelligence. See USAGE report P/01830 which describes VOLLER's plan for a "Central Agency to Fight Marxism". The plan was turned down by us.

3. A check of VLEIVA files produced no traces.
