Medical Report - Grossbahn CC-4 (A-0-636)

1. The above named individual underwent a routine medical examination on 4 March 1953.
2. History: 1938 - Scarlet Fever; no known complications or sequelae. Denies any other significant illnesses or injuries.
3. Physical Examination: Blood pressure, 110/64; Pulse, 68-86/min.; Vision, 20/40 on right, and 20/50, left; Thyroid palpable and slightly enlarged; Large furuncle scar over left shoulder.
4. Laboratory Studies: Chest x-ray, negative; Serologic test for Syphilis, negative; Urinalysis reveals a 1+ sugar reaction.
5. Disposition: Deferred; Should have a blood sugar determination, preferably drawn about 2 hours after a normal meal. If this value is within normal limits, she is qualified for full duty. I would like to be informed of this value as soon as possible.
6. NOTE: The delay in this report was due to our not having received an x-ray of this woman's chest until today (1 May 1953).
