and is on friendly terms with her. He can see the children whenever he wants.

Administrative

6. He agreed with [ ] that it would be foolish to spend the AS 10,000 on a motor scooter. Instead he will save it in a postal savings account. We arranged that [ ] would draw up a quit claim and give it to his mother to mail to him in a registered letter. He would sign it and mail it back to his mother. [ ] will then pick it up and pay his mother the money to be deposited to his account.

7. [ ] explained that the quit claim was a requirement and that it would close out our responsibility for him. He agreed. [ ] added that we might look in on him from time to time to see how he is making out. On the spot, [ ] gave him a present of AS 2000, for which he receipted.

Security

8. GROSSBAHN AA-8 has not been contacted by the Soviets at any time since his release.

Future Plans

9. GROSSBAHN AA-8 will probably stay indefinitely in Carinthia, instead of being transferred to Vienna. [ ] confirmed this on 2 January 1956.) We have, therefore, little or no operational interest in him. We could, of course, contact him at any time should the need arise. How he would react to a pitch would depend on the political situation in Austria at the time. The man himself is well disposed toward KUBARK.

Note

10. On 2 January 1956, [ ] filled agent [ ] URE in on the details of the disposal of GROSSBAHN AA-8 and asked him to keep an eye on the man. If he ever got in any kind of trouble, we might be in a position to help him. [ ], of course, headed the chain in which GROSSBAHN AA-8 once worked as an order of battle collector and has been kept informed of our handling of the GROSSBAHN AA-8 disposal.
