1. Reference is made to your memorandum dated 26 March 1958 and to previous correspondence concerning Zygmunt BORKOWSKI, wa., your file number 105-11158. Reference is also made to our teletype message (OVP-87774) of 11 May 1955 concerning Subject.

2. The following information was received on 10 April 1958 from the source who provided the information concerning Subject which was forwarded to you in our teletype message of 11 May 1955: Krupa RUDOLF (sic), an anti-Communist musician who recently returned to Argentina from the United States, told Source that he had seen Subject in New York City and said that Subject was still associating with Communists and still engaged in Communist activity.
