Reference is made to previous communications in this case, including your memorandum dated May 14, 1958, your reference CSCI-3/749,797. This memorandum advised that Krupa Rudolf (sic) had advised your source that subject was still associating with communists and still engaged in communist activity.

Enclosed are an additional report and memorandum covering further investigation in this case. You will note that no information has been developed to the effect that subject is associating with communists or engaged in communist activity. It would be appreciated, therefore, if you could arrange to obtain from Krupa Rudolf the specific facts upon which his statement was based.
