Following from FBI Liaison by telephone, 26 April 1951:

SUBJECT: Martin BORMAN

1. Bureau received the following from an informant employed by the Pittsburgh Press. This man received a letter from Johannes WERRES of Washington, D. C. The letter stated in substance that WERRES had recently returned from Germany. While in Germany, WERRES became acquainted with Walther SEFFELDT. SEFFELDT is a soccer player of considerable ability and experience, and played in Spain during 1948-1949. While in Spain SEFFELDT spoke with subject who was then residing in the village of Sabodela. He was living under the name of Jose GARCIA and was engaged in writing his memoirs and studying languages.

2. The Bureau will interview WERRES for the correct identification of SEFFELDT and will forward all information received from him.
