RE: MARTIN BORMANN

On March 8, 1965, a confidential source who does not wish to have his identity disclosed and with whom sufficient contacts have not been made to establish his reliability, advised that he had recently read an article in the March, 1965 issue of Reader's Digest concerning MARTIN BORMANN. This source advised that the general physical description as set out in this article closely resembles that of an individual by the name of AL GISH, who resides in the Americana Apartments, Annapolis, Maryland.

Confidential source further advised that GISH reportedly is engaged in confidential research work and that he left Germany shortly after World War II.

On March 9, 1965, Mrs. SUE EVANS resident member of Americana Apartments, Annapolis, Maryland advised an agent of the FBI that she does not presently have any tenant by the name of AL GISH and her records do not reflect any tenant by the name of AL GISH having resided in the Americana Apartments since these apartments were opened in July, 1960.
