Re: Martin Bormann

On September 24, 1965, Irwin G. Rice, Jr., 1324 - 79th Street, Apartment 7, Newport News, Virginia, made available three photographs which he believed to be of Bormann. Rice stated the identification of Bormann was based on another photograph he had seen of Bormann. Instant photographs are undated and their original source is not known. The original prints bear the following notation: "Presse Jnustrationen Hoffmann, Berlin SW68, Nachdruck Verboten." Rice stated he obtained the photographs from a friend who did not know the original source.

The original prints were returned to Rice.
