I know there is quite extensive information on this gent's wartime exploits available in US/British interrogations from the CI War Room -- indeed, the story of the activities of the "little Major with the wooden leg" in Northern Italy at the end of the war is used as a text in our own CE course. Would you check again, please, and send me photo copies of material you may find.
