The following preliminary personality data were provided by GASTERY-2 who interrogated BRANDT at his home in the British Zone beginning of June 1951 with a view to determining his current employment status and the scope of his knowledge on illegal KPD activities which could still be considered as of current value. Keyed to Part I of the Personal Record Questionnaire:

29. Entered the police service in 1917.

During the Weimar Republic member of Abteilung I A (Political Police) of the Berlin Police, in charge of the Communist Section (not known to []).

Transferred to the Gestapo in 1933. His special field was the illegal KPD and the "Nationalkomitee Freies Deutschland". In American internment at Nuernberg and Dachau until 1948.

Transferred to British custody in 1948.

Detained at the Esterwegen Internment Camp until 1950.

Last position held: Kriminalrat, SS Hauptsturmfuehrer (Allg SS).
