MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Cover for CAMBARO 2

1. The following is the proposed cover for [ ] 2, as discussed by [ ] of OO/Cover Division and [ ] of this office on 11 September 1952.

2. [ ] is immigrating legally to the United States. Subject will need a letter of credit from a German Bank for credit purposes here. It is proposed to give subject a legal research or research cover of a type to necessitate frequent change of office, so that he may only be reached at home.

3. CAMBARO 2 is entering the United States on a temporary visitor's visa. His cover, as proposed, is as follows:

a. Subject has been left \$1,500 by an uncle who had emigrated to the United States.

b. Subject is on leave-or-absence from [ ] (a German leather goods firm) for several months. While in the U.S.A., subject will contact leather goods firms on the Eastern seaboard, and is to be reimbursed on a commission basis by [ ] for any orders he receives.

c. Subject will explain his presence in the Washington area as follows: Subject and [ ] knew each other in Latvia and in DP camps in Europe. As subject does not know English, it is only natural for him to make [ ] home his headquarters.

4. To backstop the proposed cover stories, SR will have to provide:

a. [ ]  
(1) Letter of credit from a German Bank.

b. CAMBARO 2  
(1) A deposit of \$1,500.00 in an American Bank.
