REFERENCE(S)

1. It is requested that you obtain the current address of Dr. Ilga Brombergs and her daughter, Ingrida, who were last known to be living in Lerum, Sweden, which is apparently a suburb of or a village near Göteborg. Dr. Brombergs is said to be a dentist whose practice is in Göteborg. In addition to obtaining her exact address, we are desirous of procuring any other current information that you can collect--particularly as to her present marital status. If she has remarried, we would like to have her present husband's name and any other data available concerning him. We would also appreciate it if your source could determine what the latest husband's attitude may be towards the daughter, Ingrida. We leave to your discretion the source or sources you wish to utilize for this purpose.

2. Dr. Ilga Brombergs is the divorced wife of Arturs BROMBERGS whose capture was announced by the Soviet radio and press in September 1957. Ingrida Brombergs is the daughter of the couple. Ingrida, a minor, is the designated heir to all of her father's monies due him in accordance with the terms of his contract with K.U.B.A.R.K. In addition, Ingrida was named by her father as the beneficiary of a life insurance policy that he secured while in the United States. The total amount of money due the child is \$67,404.00. It is assumed that this emergence into "sudden wealth" will cause more than a bit of gossip among the emigres. While there is nothing much we can do to abate the gossip, every effort will be made to impress Mrs. Brombergs with the need to keep the child's inheritance as quiet as possible. We would appreciate your comments on what you anticipate the local reaction to be and any suggestions you may have for handling the financial transaction.

3. When the estate is settled, we hope to have the money passed to the child by a cleared lawyer from the West Coast area or Alaska. Since his wife is aware that her husband was in the United States and then went to Alaska, we anticipate no difficulty in having the lawyer give her a story which she will have to accept even though she may have more than reasonable doubt as to its veracity.
