[ ] agrees with the line of approach set forth in Reference regarding the settlement of the AKCASHARA/2 estate. Particularly, we agree that it is better if contact with 1/2's widow is made by someone from outside and would, therefore, welcome [ ] in this role. We see no particular need for [ ] personally to contact [ ] Station before or after his mission to Göteborg, although we would obviously be pleased to lend him any possible assistance or to discuss any problems he may foresee. In other words [ ] is welcome, but need not feel obliged to pay us a visit in [ ]. In either case, we would appreciate being kept informed of your plans for this contact—proposed cover, schedule, etc.—purely on the remote chance that there might be repercussions affecting the Station or Embassy.
