1. [] met KRMOOSKY for the purpose of straightening out the financial affairs prior to termination. At this time KRMOOSKY presented to us all the papers and copies of correspondence that he had given to [] Included in this was a driver's license under the name of Host given to him by us from TAB. KRMOOSKY stated that these were all the papers he had from us and that there was no more incriminating material with him. Financially he said his accounts would be ready on 22 December in Stuttgart. He further brought up the question of payment of travel expenses to B-59, which he said had been authorized by [] [] has verified with [] that this payment was to be made).

2. KRMOOSKY expressed again a desire, that perhaps in the future, if the situation clarified itself, he would again be working for us. [] was non-committal in his reply to this but told KRMOOSKY it was most important that he get his personal affairs straightened out with the Finance Amt. KRMOOSKY stated that this was being done and that he also was going to get a job as a representative for a company that made natural gut casings for sausages and wurst. Next contact in Stuttgart 22 December 1952.
