SPECIFIC— Contact Report - RNMOOSEY *David B. ...*

1. On 4 March 1953 [] met RNMOOSEY in Stuttgart for the purpose of discussing his contact with Dr. Graf and Prof. Boehm in Hanover over the week-end of the 28th of February.

2. RNMOOSEY reported that Prof. Boehm had no work for him at this time, but that he had received a definite offer from Dr. Graf. This offer was that RNMOOSEY would receive a salary of 1,000 DM per month for analysing communist-front publications in Sweden and Finland. Dr. Graf also stated that he would help RNMOOSEY locate an apartment somewhere in the British Zone. He was to acquaint himself with these publications for a period of about four months and then he expected that he would be sent abroad to one of these two countries. RNMOOSEY asked Dr. Graf what stood behind his little group. Dr. Graf replied that they received money from various industrialists in the West who were interested in combating communism. He affirmed, in response to a question from RNMOOSEY, that they did have connections with British Intelligence. The group which Dr. Graf worked for was made up of a small number of specialists of various areas. Dr. Graf was a specialist in Balkian affairs having previously been there with the German army. The contact, which took place in Hanover, was believed by RNMOOSEY to have been watched over by a tall British-looking man with a red mustache who had stood at the entrance of the cafe scrutinizing everybody who went in. When RNMOOSEY went in, he followed him and sat down at a near-by table from Dr. Graf and RNMOOSEY. Dr. Graf denied knowing the man. RNMOOSEY failed to learn again the first name of Dr. Graf who appeared to be well-dressed and well-paid.

3. RNMOOSEY plans to go the end of March to Munich to see his friend from UTILITY and then weigh which of the two offers is the best. [] plans to see him on the 26th of March in Stuttgart with the alternate contact on the 2nd of April.
