1. (C) Information on file indicates that Alerich BROSS, born 23 March 1904 in BROMBERG, Germany, was of security interest to your organization on 21 August 1961. Substantially the following information was furnished to you by this organization on 11 September 1961 in response to your request referenced above: Information on file at this headquarters indicates that BROSS was arrested by the British in June 1945 as the Head Commissioner of the Secret Report Service (sic) of the NSBA Art VI in Finland. (B-2) In December 1952, the LfV requested a file check on SUBJECT, who was alleged to be active for the Soviet Intelligence Service (SIS). BROSS was also alleged to be working for the US Intelligence Service (UEIS). The files contain no record of our reply to the LfV, however, the only information available to this headquarters at this time was in regard to SUBJECT'S arrest by the British in 1945. In August 1953, this headquarters received an information copy of an LfV Report regarding their investigation of SUBJECT at that time. Suggest you contact the LfV for further details, reference file # IIL/G-41-098-01/35-71/53, dated 22 August 1953, LfV DUESSELDORF. The files further contain an information card reflecting that SUBJECT was dropped as an informant of an unidentified Allied Intelligence Agency on 10 August 1954, due to HIS inability to fulfill the requirements set forth by the employing agency. In December 1956, SUBJECT was again traced by LfV BERLIN, this time in connection with that agency's investigation of one Herbert Skrypietz, born 11 December 1900 at KALUSBERG/Prussia, who was alleged to be connected with SIS, and all available information was forwarded. SUBJECT is further recorded in Central Registry files as having used the following aliases: Alarech and Alerich BROSS; Alerich BROES; Ulrich ROBE; Richard MUELLER; (fnu) YIGLA; Walter WEISS; (fnu) RICHTER; (fnu) BRUNO, and Dr. (fnu) HOLST. (B-2) No further pertinent information available.
