| <p>1. You may inform CATUSE that we have no information on Alarich Alfons Johann BROSS [] subsequent to the replies in reference to their 1961 trace request.</p> <p>2. We have two traces which may be identical to the Hans Ferdinand WEISSFELD mentioned in reference:</p> <p>a. BGMA-8033 dated 8 March 1951 mentioned one Hans Ferdinand WEISSFELD and his son, Hans Peter WEISSFELD, in connection with the controversy over the book <u>Die Rote Kapelle</u>. Both men were described as "unsavory and troublesome." This dispatch gave no other background or biographic information on WEISSFELD.</p> <p>b. BGMA-24512 dated 27 November 1950 also mentions Hans Ferdinand and Hans Peter WEISSFELD; however, we cannot locate this document.</p> | | | |
