M/R: [] stopped by to state that she and [] met BRUECKNER at the Union Station last night (train was late), and drove him to their home. BRUECKNER was tired, but seemed at ease and stated he was happy to stay in an American home. He likes to cook, and helped [] prepare an evening snack. He said he cooks the evening meal for his family in Germany. [] is acting as hostess and had indicated that she has a job for the summer month. [] and BRUECKNER stayed up for a short while discussing generalities et after [] went to bed. She suggested that we talk to [] for additional info.

M/R: [] called at 11 a.m. and said that BRUECKNER is leaving Washington by train on Saturday night to go to Chicago, Milwaukee, New York, and New Haven. (Presumably the trip which Adenauer will take.) BRUECKNER went to the German Embassy this morning and from there will go to State where he has an appointment later in the day.
