1. Ernst BRUECKNER was born on 9 December 1909 in Magdeburg, Germany. He attended the Reform-Realgymnasium and Domgymnasium in Magdeburg, and later studied political science, law and political economy at the Universities of Marburg and Halle. After he had passed his state examinations (in Hamburg in 1933, and in Berlin in 1937), he worked in various Public Prosecutors' offices in Hamburg, Torgau, Halle, Nordhausen and Magdeburg. From 1939 until 1953 he was District Attorney in Itzehoe. On 3 August 1957 he was appointed Chief of the Security Group, a Division of the Federal Criminal Office of West Germany.

2. Subject is married to the former Elly DOERR. The couple has three children, a son and two daughters.
