MEMORANDUM TO: Chief, Counter Intelligence Staff
THROUGH : CI/OA
SUBJECT : Admission of Foreign Nationals to Agency Premises

1. In accordance with CBI Ex. 50-7, 29 July 1960, permission is hereby requested to admit a German National to Agency premises.
2. The individual concerned is Dr. Ernst HEUSCHNER, Chief of the Security Group (SG) for West Germany.
3. In connection with a previous clearance Subject was assigned C-32626. According to a cross-reference form in Subject's 201 this file is held in RI/AR, WASH CIA-PERS-4.
4. Subject has expressed a desire to meet briefly with EE personnel on 4 or 5 April 1961. Any meetings which take place will be held in the Administration Building complex (East, Central, Admin, etc.). During the week of 10-15 April 1961 Subject will again be in Washington at which time it will be necessary to admit him to Agency premises for discussions with C.I.A. personnel.
5. A more detailed schedule of the planned meetings including their locations will be forwarded by separate memorandum as soon as possible. In the meantime we would appreciate your expediting the issuance of a pass to Mr. HEUSCHNER so that, if necessary, he may be admitted to Agency premises on 4 April.
