- Dr. Brueckner, during his short stay in Washington in connection with Chancellor Adenauer's visit, was met by [] for lunch on 4 April, and was entertained along with Sturm, member of the Bavarian LfV, at a stag party the evening of 10 April at the home of []. The party was attended by []. During his Washington visit Dr. Brueckner resided with the []. On 12 April Dr. Brueckner gave a 2-hour lecture on SovBloc operations in West Germany, exhibiting and discussing various items of SovBloc gear and propaganda material. This lecture was attended by approximately 90 persons and was very well received. Dr. Brueckner gave the same lecture to ODEWV on 13 April.
- Nothing of substance was discussed with Dr. Brueckner during this visit, although we were able to obtain from him a copy of the 1960 SG report of police criminal statistics on crimes against the state. Attached to this dispatch is a receipt for this publication which we neglected to return to Dr. Brueckner. Since he may be personally charged for this document we are returning this receipt to him.
