<p>1. Attached for all addressees is a set of photographs of a known KGB case officer. UPHILL requests addressees furnish any identifications they might be able to make.</p> <p>2. UPHILL photographed the case officer in Rome during the 1960 Summer Olympic games (small photographs) and also in Vienna in September 1961 (large photograph). The man used the name "Heinz" in his meetings with an UPHILL double agent and is described as follows:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"> <i>Doesn't match Heinz's Heinz</i> </p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"> DOB: circa 1910 Height: about 168 cm Build: strong, athletic, thick-set Face: full, round, pug-nosed Hair: blond, cut short Hands: clean, well-cared-for hands with clean, manicured fingernails Other: no distinguishing characteristics; wore a square watch with a copper-colored face and a grey leather band on his left wrist </p> <p>3. Although not mentioned by UPHILL, it appears to us that the man bears a rather striking resemblance to KRUSCHCHEV.</p> <p>4. In addition to meeting the UPHILL double agent in Rome in August 1960, "Heinz" was to have met the double agent again in Geneva in early 1961, a meeting which finally took place in Vienna on 11 September 1961. UPHILL also has reason to believe that "Heinz" was in London during the Soviet Trade Exhibition there in mid summer 1960 and that he accompanied the exhibit to Paris.</p> <p>5. UPHILL and Munich files contain no clues to "Heinz" identity.</p> <p>6.
