1. Forwarded under separate cover are two test letters sent to CABATON 31 and CABATON 42.

2. The letter sent to CABATON 31 was unintentionally opened by him. He assures us he opened the letter inadvertently before he realized it was not intended for him. We are inclined to accept his version and suggest that another letter be sent to this address. The letter was received by him on 16 May and turned over to us on the 18th.

3. The letter sent to CABATON 42 was mailed to us by CABATON 38 on 18 May. We picked it up from our local post box on 19 May. We note that the letter was initially postmarked 15 May in Berlin. Since it had to be sent from Hildesheim to CABATON 38 in Uelzen, and then on to us, this would appear to be fairly rapid service for this channel. On receipt of the letter we noted that the flap on the right side was separated from the body of the envelope, as if the glue had not been moistened enough.
