1. SUMMARY: During the period under review we have added 6 new accommodation addresses and dropped 4, giving us a total of 31 active addresses as of 30 September 1960. Of this total 11 (CABATONS/23, 29, 31, 32, 39, 41, 42, 43, 47, 49, and 51) have been assigned exclusively to BOB, in addition to those shared by BOB with other Bases and Stations. Six (CABATONS/25, 35, 37, 38, 40, and 46) are available for non-Block assignments only, and 11 (CABATONS/21, 22, 24, 26, 27, 30, 44, 45, 48, 50, and 56) are available for any type assignment. CABATONS/1 ~~is~~ ~~is~~ each carrying a full load, and CABATON/33 is assigned to a  ~~]~~ operation which we feel is adequate for this asset. In addition to the above, we expect to have CABATONS/54 and 55 available shortly, and as soon as certain questions concerning CABATONS/52 and 53 can be resolved they may also be available in the near future.

She recalled having received it but destroyed it after reading the innocuous comments, failing to connect the letter with us. Since the name used on the letter was completely different from the name we had alerted her to, we feel her actions were natural.

Comments: This agent is an unwitting drop handled by CABATON/38. Because of the extra time involved in forwarding mail from agent to PA to us, BOB transferred CATHYROID/2 to CABATON/49.

Comments: An unwitting live drop handled by CABATON/38; performance satisfactory.

This agent has never been assigned to an operation. The address was used by FOB/SOV for developmental correspondence with a young student in the USSR, and the exchange was limited to stamp collecting, exchange of books and prints, and a few personal tidbits. In view of the completely innocuous nature of this correspondence which has now ceased, we feel that this agent can be given an assignment.

Comments: Has performed satisfactorily with test letters.

Comments: The recent attempt, apparently by the Polish IS, to identify the addressee for AERNAUTICAL 2's mail as reported in EGFA 30179, 7 April 1960, is being investigated here along the lines suggested by Headquarters' EGFW 11160, 22 August 1960.

Comments: Agent informed her mother of her work for us, and the mother told the daughter she is old enough to know what she is doing. We don't expect any problems in this case.

Comments: This is an unwitting agent controlled by CABATON/38. We now have an OA on this agent which provides us with another address; however, it must be remembered that the service will be somewhat slow since the mail must be forwarded to us via CABATON/38.

Comments: Agent performance is satisfactory.

Comments: Agent was recruited by AECORSAIR/9 in 1957 as an LLD but was never used. FOB/SOV turned the agent over to us early this year and on 6 April she expressed her willingness to work for us.

Comments: This agent's status was reported in detail in EGFA 31778, 26 August 1960.

Comments: Our contact with this agent was detailed in EGFA 30294, 18 April 1960. We are presently attempting to clarify the question raised in EGFW 11119, 19 August 1960.

Comments: We are presently attempting to determine if the derogatory traces mentioned in EGFW 10914, 21 July 1960, pertain to the agent.

Comments: The status of this agent was reported in detail in EGFA 31664, 15 August 1960, to which PRQ Part II was attached, and we are now awaiting full operational approval.

Comments: PRQ Part II will be submitted shortly.

CABATON/56

Case Officer [ ]

Assignments: None.

Comments: Agent has accepted recruitment and will be paid at a rate of DM 50 per month. PRQ Part II and MOA will be submitted shortly.

3. AGENT PROSPECTS: We have at present a small number of prospects and these will be reported on as they are developed. Since the previous Progress Report was written, we have reviewed the large number of dormant leads now in our Prospects Folder and find that very few of these people are suitable for further development.

4. OTHER MAIL FACILITIES: We now have a total of 21 Post Office boxes in the Frankfurt area and one in Wiesbaden. We hope to increase this number in the near future but are severely limited by the scarcity of boxes. These boxes are serviced from one to three times weekly, depending on flow and urgency of incoming letters.

5. SECURITY: The major security incident of note concerns the apparent Polish IS attempt to identify the CABATON/46 letter drop. This development has been the subject of separate correspondence.

6. FINANCES: During this reporting period our monthly payroll has been increased by DM 275 with the addition of CABATONS/43 through 46, and reduced by DM 200 by dropping CABATON/19 and reducing to DM 100 CABATON/40's salary. This gives us a net increase of DM 75 per month, an amount which is well within the forecast for expenditures for the present and coming fiscal years. The total amount expended during the reporting period was [ ]

7. DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING: We are continuing our efforts toward the development and recruitment of new agents on a modest and more selective basis. We are attempting to acquire at least a few more addresses which can be used under various names; for example, the pension owners, and in addition will continue our spotting and assessing efforts so as to provide a backlog of possible assets to meet any emergency requirement that might arise. Although we could well intensify our spotting and recruiting to meet increased needs, particularly if the Berlin situation worsens, we must necessarily balance our expansion effort against case officer strength available to handle existing and future assets. At our present rate of expansion we anticipate we may soon reach a level of approximately 40 accommodation addresses, not an inconsiderable load for two case officers who are also occupied with other duties.

8. COMMENT: We regret very much our tardiness in preparing and forwarding this Progress Report. This belatedness is due mainly to a complete changeover in case officers during the reporting period. Some changes have obviously taken place since this report was prepared, but rather than attempt to revise it we decided to hold to the cutoff date of 30 September and note subsequent developments, some of which have been otherwise reported, in the next Progress Report. We plan to submit future Progress Reports on a quarterly basis.
