MEMORANDUM FOR: Assistant Director for Policy Coordination
FROM : Deputy Director (Plans)
SUBJECT : Amendment No. 3 to Project TPEMBER

1. I return to you herewith for further consideration the above-mentioned project which has been submitted for my approval and for PRC review. I am troubled about this project in view of the fact that the new amendment proposed would open up an entirely new line of activity for this organization -- one which is not germane to its present activities and which would tend to distract the attention and dilute the effort of this organization which is primarily designed for work in the cold war psychological warfare field. I also have the impression that we are getting to the point where we seem to be tacking a paramilitary tail onto too many of our major organizational activities in Germany. (I should like to know how many different sets of paramilitary efforts we now have for Germany.) If my impression in this latter regard is correct, we may find the traffic so heavy as to result in representatives of the different organizations falling over each other in the night and digging up one another's caches.

2. I should appreciate your reviewing this matter carefully and letting me know what you think of my questions and observations.
