## CAGENERAL PROJECT RENEWAL

## A. CURRENT OBJECTIVES

1. THE CAGENERAL PROJECT PROVIDES SUPPORT TO ALL MOB CLANDESTINE OPERATIONS WHICH INVOLVE OPEN MAIL COMMUNICATIONS. CAGENERAL ALSO PROVIDES SUPPORT TO CERTAIN OPERATIONS UNDER THE CONTROL OF HQS AND OTHER STATIONS AND BASES. THE PROJECT CURRENTLY PROVIDES FOR 21 LIVE LETTER DROPS AND 5 POST OFFICE BOXES.

## B. CHANGES

2. DURING THE CURRENT PROJECT YEAR, ALL LIVE LETTER DROPS WHO WERE NO LONGER CONSIDERED USABLE BECAUSE OF POSSIBLE COMPROMISE OR OTHR FACTORS HAVE BEEN TERMINATED, I.E., CAGENERAL/11, 13, 21, 25 AND 26. TO REPLACE THOSE CAGENERALS WHO WERE TERMINATED, MOB RECRUITED CAGENERAL/32 THROUGH 37 AND [ ] WHO HAS NOT YET BEEN ASSIGNED A CAGENERAL NUMBER.

3. NO NEW POST OFFICE BOXES HAVE BEEN RENTED DURING THE PROJECT YEAR.
