1. Area of Operations and Base: Germany, Frankfurt (Berlin Operations Base).
2. References: None
3. Aims: a) Objectives: To locate possible penetration agents in the HVDVP, HVA and MSS, to furnish documentation intelligence and to perform name checks through East Sector Berlin police files.
 b) Targets: The Soviet Sector Berlin Polizeipräsidium and DDR police circles.
 c) Tasks: To maintain his position within the East Berlin police and his standing in the SED; to perform name checks and furnish operational leads.
4. Personnel: CARBOHYDRATE.
5. Cover: Agent can fulfill the objectives of the operation in the normal exercise of his assigned police functions.
6. Contact and Communications: Agent comes to West Berlin, by appointment, approximately once a month; he is picked up and taken to an operational house for briefing and debriefing. For emergency contacts, agent is called at his East Sector apartment, caller asking to speak to "Herr SEIDEL". Agent then comes to the West Sector and calls agent phone number. When police duties prevent agent from coming to West Berlin, his wife can act as courier.
7. Control: To a large extent based on our payments of salary which allow agent to better support for his family; to a degree on dislike shared by agent and

wife of Soviets and Communist system; documentary evidence that agent has furnished American intelligence organization with information and has received monetary payments for his services.

8. Special Equipment: None at present. SW equipment might have to be furnished to agent in the event that Soviets enforce more rigid control over persons passing between East and West Berlin.
9. Coordination: None.
10. Timetable: Agent has been in our employ since May 1948; termination of the project is envisaged only when the operation is proved to be unprofitable or when agent is forced to flee.
11. Estimated Cost:
 - Compensation: 300 EM West monthly salary; 200 to be paid agent and 100 to be deposited to agent's holding account.
 - Travel: None
 - Operating Expenses: Bonus not to exceed one month's salary for leads resulting in successful recruitments in target organizations.
12. Special Problems and Commitments: With regard to disposal, BOB is committed to evacuate the agent and his family from Berlin to the U.S. Zone; moral obligation would involve housing, documentation, food and financial assistance for at least three months in such an event.
