 SPECIFIC: CARBONHYDRATE

REF: MGBA-16064

1. Your objective reaction to our throwing cold water on your long-standing operation is appreciated. We were not aware that CARBONHYDRATE was in a position to check East Berlin police files for you or to obtain continuing data on documentation which is not available to other residents of East Berlin. Since an allocation has already been made to cover the CARBONHYDRATE Project through 30 September, we would like to see you try him on the new targets until that date on the reduced budget proposed in para. 4 of reference. If he agrees to the reduced salary and has shown his usefulness on police file checks, document intelligence and/or SSD and EVA leads by then, a new project outline can be approved on a yearly basis.

2. In the meanwhile, it is suggested that you talk over the operation frankly with CARBONHYDRATE, telling him that your Headquarters has cut your budget and no longer requires his reports on the East Sector police. He may be able to propose other ways in which he can be useful. For instance, in our great need for investigative facilities in the Soviet Zone, he may be able to spot police officials in the Laender Headquarters or individuals who can be used for surveillance and neighborhood checks. If you conclude that he is of no further use to BOB after 30 September, you might assess him for the job of setting up an investigative unit in the American Zone and sound him out on this possibility. If he is willing, we are sure COS would be glad to inherit a competent policeman to set up an investigative team somewhere in the Zone. If you would not recommend him for this job, or if it would offend his pride, how about offering him to DYGLUCK or even possibly to the Berlin AFV to report on SED and FDJ demonstrations? The latter suggestion is made without knowledge here of the AFV's operational budget or the security implications over.
