1. SACARAKA-2 was met by [] on 10 August 1953. At this meeting she was told that a letter (drafted by [] and CARBOHYDRATE) refusing her application for employment with CADMOIT had been signed by LAMBL. Inasmuch as this letter was dated 10 August, it was not certain that it would, if normally posted, reach her in time for her to take to her SBU case officer the following evening; SACARAKA-2 was therefore instructed that she should pick up the letter at CARBOHYDRATE's residence that same evening. (An envelope addressed to SACARAKA-2 which she was to take along in the event of its timely arrival--was posted on 10 August for basketop purposes.) A copy of this letter is forwarded as attachment "A" to this dispatch. SACARAKA-2 was also to take a letter of her own composition for CADRAIN. The only other detail SACARAKA-2 was to report to the SBU case officer was that her mother-in-law had found (as he had insisted that the old lady do) living quarters of her own.

2. SACARAKA-2 was again met by [] on 13 August 1953, at which time she reported that the SBU case officer had been waiting for her upon her arrival at the Ernst Thälmann 8-Straße according to schedule (2000, 11 August). This time, however, he was not in a cab/four-driven vehicle, but was himself driving a Topolini 2-seater convertible. SACARAKA-2 was unable to determine the license number. A report written by SACARAKA-2 on this meeting is forwarded as attachment "B" to this dispatch. In addition to the contents of this report, the following points should be noted: (1) the SBU case officer said that now that SACARAKA-2's mother-in-law had moved, he had no further interest in what her relatives did.

(2) CACARANA-2 received no money; and (3) she was again promised that she would "eventually" be allowed to see CACARANA. The portion of her letter to CACARANA to which the SSD case officer objected was a small section in which she had written that since CACARANA's arrest she had heard no reproaches against him from friends or acquaintances; rather, on the contrary, most of these people did not feel that he deserved to be imprisoned.

3. In preparation for her next SSD meeting, CACARANA-2 will be briefed to carry out the SSD case officer's instructions; she will attempt to see [] and she will go to DTLINEN to apply for a job. These steps will be coordinated with the CADRAIN staff officers concerned. She will also be briefed on how to report to the SSD case officer the results of the approaches she was instructed to make to CARBONYWATZ.
