Comments on CARBOHYDRATE'S LCFLUTTER

REF: KCBA-11637 dated 8 February 1954

1. The undersigned wishes to point out a misstatement in the above-referenced report. In paragraph 2 it is stated that the undersigned expressed his opinion as to the future viability of CARBOHYDRATE in his present sensitive position. It is further stated that the undersigned did not feel that it was necessary to separate CARBOHYDRATE from his CARROIT employment.

2. At the meeting with [] and [] the undersigned stated that CARBOHYDRATE'S patterns on LCFLUTTER charts indicated that he was not practicing deception in those questions relating to the Subject's contact with Surète. Although Subject showed sensitivity to some aspects of the connection with Surète (Ref: EGQA-33676) it was felt and expressed by the undersigned that Subject was basically telling the truth during his LCFLUTTER examination.

3. As an LCFLUTTER examiner the undersigned is not authorized to state whether the individuals given an examination can or cannot continue with their work regardless of the sensitivity ascribed to their positions. As an LCFLUTTER examiner the undersigned also cannot give a final clearance to an individual or place value judgments on the security implications of past contacts with such organizations as Surète.

4. It is felt certain that [] did not intentionally misquote the undersigned but rather implied that a comparatively clear run on LCFLUTTER indicated the examiner's approval of CARBOHYDRATE'S continued use with CARROIT.
