## 1. C. delivered:

## a. Written report on meeting with Henry Simon, Quersandenweg 36.

C. had ~~written~~ written a note to Hans-Wolfgang S., asking him to come to the office for a discussion (re why he had told the police that he was ~~working~~ working with CAIROIT, when in fact he was not). Henry said he was a student of law (Hans W. is a student of medicine, supposedly), lives near Hans W, but is not identical with Hans W. Mail for Hans W. is sometimes delivered by error to Henry, as had the letter from C. ~~Henry~~ Henry told C. that he was engaged in some sort of work "similar to C.'s" and used a covername in this respect. Henry gave no further details, however.

II b. Written report on arrest on 11 Sept of Guenther S. at Ohlsen's initiative. S. had helped the SSD to arrest a woman in the DDR (who had later fled after her release). Abt. V stated on 12 Sept that S. had confessed working for the SS ~~against~~ against CAIROIT and DTLINER and to having denounced to the SS<sup>u</sup> the woman who later fled to the West.

c. Written report on ~~the~~ the cousin of Krebs. As noted earlier, the cousin and his fiancée have fled to West B\_erlin. This report (the last to be expected) gives details of the SS<sup>u</sup> handling of the cousin.

d. The file on MA ~~Horst~~ Horst Siemens. (To be returned to C. by 29 Sept, if possible).

2.  requested a CAIROIT nametrace on Josef G.

3.  requested a report on the request of K5 for the file on Hein, Zieckler.

4.  suggested that the MA involved in the captain W. case be turned over to Dr. Berndt for help in getting the desired divorce and getting his child

C. reported orally that he had <sup>a</sup> candidate for the CALCINO house on 1530 of the date of this contact, but ~~was~~ that it had not been possible to send the candidate over, since Frau K. in the house is not there after 1500. C. noted that this has ~~happened before~~ happened before, and that business for the CALCINO house has been lost thereby.

6. C. reported orally that he had had an SSD spitzel arrested through the W. Berlin police, but that through an ~~administrative~~ error of K5, the spitzel had been let go prematurely. Full written report to follow.
