

4. The recent cases of Stein of RIAS and Fricke have caused a good bit of comment within CADROIT. Many staffers are wondering who in CADROIT will be next (a common reaction after such cases).

5. CARBO noted that Abt. V had made a mistake in the Fricke case. They had released Trittungen due to lack of evidence, ~~without~~ without checking with CADROIT to see what the latter had. CADROIT had considerable derog material in its B Kartel on Trittungen. [] suggested that this opportunity be taken to establish a ~~regular~~ regular and firm procedure under which Abt. V would name trace with CADROIT in all similar cases before releasing due to lack of evidence. ~~with~~ CARBO agreed. He will speak to ~~some~~ Kierich of Abt. [] therefore instructed CARBO that the matter was closed.
