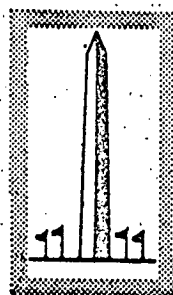
Some of these reporters have already been syndicated from time to time on an informal basis.
