

Ex-FBI Agent Is Indicted

Washington, May 13 (AP) — A Federal grand jury today indicted John Joseph Frank, 42-year-old Washington attorney and former FBI agent, on charges of acting for the Dominican Republic in this country without registering as a foreign agent.

Frank also is a former employé of the Central Intelligence Agency.

The four - count indictment said Frank, "also known as John Kane," was a Dominican agent from about May, 1954, until the present.

Frank was accused of collecting information for Generalissimo Rafael Trujillo, the Dominican dictator.
