MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Trip Report of Apollo VII Photography

1. [redacted] and myself representing COMIREX, [redacted] Representing DIA arrived at NASA, Houston, Texas facility prior to the receipt of the photography from the Apollo VII space flight. The purpose of our visit was to insure that the photography does not compromise information vital to the United States or other sovereignties.

2. The material arrived at the NASA facility in a sealed container and was inventoried prior to processing. [redacted] [redacted] observed the processing to insure all material was processed and that only two reproductions made. The original and one reproduction were controlled until the other reproduction was viewed by the team [redacted].

3. When it was determined that the imagery would not jeopardize any nation's security [redacted] "released" all the imagery to be used at the discretion of Dr. Gilruth, Director of the Houston NASA facility.

4. NASA provided [redacted] a complete reproduction of all the still photography acquired on the mission. This material will be retained at NPIC and does not contain any restrictive classification.

5. Selected frames were shown at the Director's briefing (NPIC) Friday, 25 October 1968. Additional selected frames are to be shown to the COMIREX Committee Thursday, 31 October.
