6. (Internal Use Only - PLC) LIAISON Met with Ralph Costeel, Staff Member, House Committee on Veterans' Affairs and discussed Public Law 94-491 which extends veterans' medical benefits to any person who served as a member of any armed forces of the governments of Czechoslovakia or Poland in armed conflict with an enemy of the United States. Costeel said that the certification required under the act should be kept personally by the beneficiary and should only be shown when medical treatment is needed. He added that the medical treatment under the Act must be limited to within the United States. This inquiry was prompted by a request from [redacted] who has an STAT employee who may be eligible for benefits under the Act.

7. (Unclassified - LJK) LIAISON At the request of Bill Barr, OLC, I asked Guy McConnell, Subcommittee on Defense, Senate Appropriations Committee staff, if Chairman John L. McClellan (D., Ark.), Senate Appropriations Committee, provided IC budget figures to Senators not on the Appropriations Committee. McConnell said that such figures were provided on a confidential basis at the request of the individual Senators.

8. (Unclassified - LJK) LIAISON James Oliver, Office of Management and Budget, called to request a copy of the "General Restrictions" study prepared for the House and Senate Appropriations Committees. A copy was delivered by courier.
