

South Vietnam: A Communist document recently captured northeast of Saigon provides an indication of the extent of local recruitment by the Viet Cong. The document lists 3,336 persons recruited from January through 13 June 1962. Data in the document on about one third of the recruits show that they were largely in the 17-30 age group and came from provinces near Saigon. At least 400 were females. Many of the recruits were destined for assignment to key political or military cadres. The document apparently deals with recruiting in only one region of South Vietnam; the figures thus do not give a nationwide picture.

Haiti: (President Duvalier may be receiving arms of Communist bloc origin. According to US military observers in Port-au-Prince, civil militiamen on 3 August were maintaining unusually strict guard on the wharf there to protect packing cases bearing Czech markings. On 10 August former armed forces chief of staff Boucicaut, now in asylum in the Venezuelan Embassy in the capital, stated that while visiting the President two weeks ago he had seen a submachine gun of a type unfamiliar to him being displayed in the palace. This weapon was in the possession of an official hitherto suspected of being implicated in arms transactions. The general added that an army officer in good standing with Duvalier later remarked that he was training militiamen in the use of 75 new subma-
