Yugoslavia-USSR-Poland: (Recent discussions between Yugoslavia and the USSR apparently resulted in a partial accommodation in their party-to-party relations. Further talks aimed at reconciling ideological differences may follow.)

(The Polish party, at least, appears to be in concert with Moscow. [redacted])

[redacted] the 3-12 October visit to Poland of Yugoslav politburo member Bakaric had more to do with party relations than appeared on the surface.)

(Bakaric, leading a delegation of the Tito regime's mass political organization, talked with many high Polish party leaders, including Gomulka. He probably discussed the question of a Tito visit to Poland.)

(Warsaw has just announced that Foreign Minister Rapacki will visit Belgrade late this month.)
