
East Germany - Poland - Czechoslovakia: Representatives of Poland, Czechoslovakia, and East Germany are working on a joint plan for the industrial development and exploitation of mineral deposits in the Niesse River border area. Such arrangements for border areas in the past have been carried out only by bilateral agreement. This three-way discussion began on 6 June under CEMA auspices, presumably as a development in the USSR's economic integration program of the European satellites.

USSR--Leadership: Khrushchev's long-time deputy, Anastas Mikoyan, underwent a "serious lung operation" sometime in early May. Khrushchev has said that the operation was successful, and Mikoyan's son stated on 23 May that his father was expected to leave the hospital before the end of the month. While the exact nature of the operation is not known, Mikoyan reportedly contracted influenza when he went to Murmansk to meet Fidel Castro on 26 April and then complications developed.

Iran: Government forces have been able to keep the rioting in Tehran from seriously threatening the regime, but damage has been extensive and the situation remains tense. The government has implied that it will turn Rouhollah Khomeini, whom it blames for the outburst of violence, over to a military court for trial under martial law. Government spokesmen have said that no leniency will be shown the riot ring-leaders, but the execution of Khomeini, one of Iran's most eminent religious leaders, could provoke further outbreaks.
