





**\*Brazil: Attacks on US policies by Brazilian representatives at international conferences appear designed to demonstrate the Goulart government's "independent" position.**

Last week, a Brazilian delegate to the Preparatory Committee of the UN Conference on Trade and Development made a bitterly sarcastic speech denouncing US policies on international trade and economic aid to underdeveloped countries. This shrill criticism stood in contrast to the opinion of delegates from such non-aligned countries as India and Yugoslavia who privately expressed sympathy for the US position.

More anti-American barbs may be unleashed by the Brazilian delegation to the ILO conference that got under way on 5 June. The group includes the extreme leftist Minister of Labor, Almino Alfonso, and a Communist Party member as its chief labor representative.

Meanwhile, it was announced in Rio de Janeiro yesterday that Finance Minister Dantas has accepted an invitation to visit the USSR. The date was not announced. Dantas is expected to seek Soviet economic aid.

**\*Peru:** Fernando Belaunde Terry established an early and sizable lead in unofficial returns from the 9 June presidential election. However, his leading opponent, Victor Raul Haya de la Torre, will narrow this lead as returns come in from northern Peru. Belaunde's lead may also be jeopardized by charges of vote fraud in the northern states of Ancash and Cajamarca where the army failed to deliver official ballots--and where Haya got overwhelming majorities in 1962.
