



25X1 JORDAN-USSR: After several months of tempo-
rizing over King Husayn's request to visit Moscow,
the Soviets on 19 July informed the Jordanians that
they will be delighted to receive the King at any
time. [redacted]

25X1 [redacted] The timing and reported urgency with
which the response was delivered suggest a quick
move by Moscow to cultivate the King in the after-
math of events in Egypt and probably foreshadow ad-
ditional Soviet efforts to shore up relations with
the other Arab states. [redacted]
