





INDIA: The Minister of Agriculture told the US ambassador last week that the government plans to buy 4 million tons of wheat and sorghum in the US during the year ending in March 1974.

[Redacted] So far, however, actual purchases have been limited in the hope that prices for grain might drop or that the US or Canada might offer food aid. Officials responsible for food-grain distribution in India are very concerned about the tight food situation that will occur during September and October before the fall grain harvest.

India's production of spring wheat this year is now estimated at 25 to 26 million tons, compared with 26.5 million tons last year. The crop in the Punjab, a leading wheat producing state, will probably be down by 20-25 percent, and total government procurement of wheat is unlikely to exceed last year's level, despite nationalization of the grain trade on 1 April.

The size of the fall harvest, mostly rice and other grains, will depend to a large extent on the current monsoon. During its first two weeks, the monsoon brought normal rainfall but weakened during the third week, particularly in the central and southeastern parts of the country that were hardest hit by the recent drought.






