- Licensing conditions are the same as in the Federal Republic of Germany as far as technical matters are concerned. The administrative procedure is, however, very different. Only members of the Socialist Union Party (SED) controlled Gesellschaft fuer Sport und Technik (Society for Sports and Technical Education) are permitted to submit applications to the postal authorities who have the licensing responsibility. The applications are submitted through the Society and only reach the postal authorities after appropriate recommendations have been made.
- There is as yet [July 1953] no official tie-in between DARC and any responsible amateur body of the Soviet Zone.
