The following table shows the distribution of gross production in all branches of the Serbian economy for 1947, 1948, and 1949:

	1947	1948	1949
Industry	29.9	31.0	32.6
Agriculture	42.8	39.1	34.4
All other branches of the economy	27.3	29.9	33.0
Total production	100.0	100.0	100.0

Between 1947 and 1949, there was a 15-percent increase in industrial production and a 15-percent decrease in agricultural production.

The following table shows the distribution of the Serbian national income in 1949 and 1950 (in millions of dinars):

Total national income	227,691	245,870	8.7
Industry	84,878	93,606	10.3
Agriculture	79,511	81,851	3.0

At present, the socialist sector in Serbia has 18.7 percent of all the arable land in the republic, while in 1947 it had only 6.7 percent. Serbian farm work cooperatives now include 175,000 families.

Industrial production in 1947 amounted to 11 billion dinars; in 1948, 19.5 billion dinars; in 1949, 23.3 billion dinars; and in 1950, 30.6 billion dinars.

The total value of consumers' goods produced in 1948 was 30,668,918,000 dinars, in terms of lower uniform prices; in 1949, 36,100,575,000 dinars; and in 1950, 41,398,048,000 dinars. In 1950, Serbian consumers' goods factories produced 2,510 dinars' worth of goods per capita.
