PLANS FOR NINTH ALL-UNION RADIO EXHIBITION

The Central Committee of the All-Union DOSARM Council, the Central Committee of the All-Union Lenin Young Communist League, the Ministry of Communications, and the Ministry of the Communications Equipment Industry jointly passed a resolution establishing the period between 7 and 20 May 1951 as the date for the Ninth All-Union Radio Exhibition.

The purpose of the exhibition is to demonstrate the achievements of Soviet radio amateurs and designers, the aid given by the party and state to the development of designing by radio amateurs, and the improvement in all the work of DOSARM organizations and clubs in propagandizing the science of radio engineering.

Homemade radio equipment may be entered provided the design, circuit, or purpose of the equipment presents some new feature or creative idea. In the case of receivers intended for radiofication of rural kolkhozes, the main requisites for acceptance will be trouble-free operation and suitability for mass production.

For the best exhibits, 65 prizes have been established, totaling 60,000 rubles, in the following divisions: application of radio methods in the national economy; short-wave receiving equipment; ultrashort-wave equipment; television; measuring equipment and visual aids; sound-recording and amplifying equipment; power supplies; telemechanics and radar.

Furthermore, the Ministry of Communications has established three special prizes for outstanding designs of radio equipment and instruments which are of value in radiofication or radio communications. The first prize will be 15,000 rubles, the second prize 10,000 rubles, and the third prize 5,000 rubles.

All authors awarded prizes will be given first-class certificates. Those who are given honorable mention will receive second-class certificates.
