Nikolay Aleksandrovich Dygay was appointed Minister of Construction USSR. (1) In January 1954, D. Ya. Rayzer was First Deputy Minister of Construction USSR. (2) Goldin was a Deputy Minister of Construction USSR in April 1954. (3) ... S.
